W E E K 1	<p>June 20 – 24</p> <p><u>Me and My Family--Portraits in Painting, Drawing and Collage</u></p> <p>Teacher : Carlos Perez</p>	<p>This class offers fun, interactive explorations of painting, drawing, and collage techniques through a variety of media. Student will learn about line, shape, color and composition while creating self-portraits or portraits of family members. At the end of the week artists will have a portrait ready for framing to hang proudly at home.</p>
W E E K 2	<p>June 27 – July 1</p> <p><u>Oceans of Fun</u></p> <p>Teacher : Samantha Miller</p>	<p>In this exciting week students will transform the classroom into a dazzling underwater scene. Starting with an 'ocean' painted with oil pastels, watercolors, and sponge paint, artists will use a variety of materials to create & fill it with fanciful fish, underwater plants, and giant stuffed sea creatures--plants and animals we know, and others we haven't yet met. At the end of our ocean week, our creatures will swim home with their creators!</p>
W E E K 3	<p>July 5 – 8</p> <p><u>Growing a Garden</u></p> <p>Teacher : Samantha Miller</p>	<p>Our garden will be like no other in the world--one filled with plants, flowers and animals of every shape, color and description. Using a variety of paper and paints, and objects such as beads, wire, tissue paper, magazines and more, students will turn our room into a glorious garden! At the end of our fabulous week, our creation will be carefully disassembled and artists will take their artwork home.</p>
W E E K 4	<p>July 11 – 15</p> <p><u>Clay and Mosaics from A to Z</u></p> <p>Teacher : Jane Gardner</p>	<p>Do you like to play with clay? In this class, students will learn the skills and techniques to create something they like--a treasure box, a bug or butterfly or favorite animal, miniature furniture, even a toothbrush holder. While our ceramic pieces are drying for glazing and firing, we will make some beautiful mosaic stones to decorate the yard or garden. When the class ends, artists will have some unique pieces for indoors and out !</p>
W E E K 5	<p>July 18 – 22</p> <p><u>Art Takes Flight</u></p> <p>Teacher : Barbara Adams</p>	<p>If you were a bird, what colors would you be? The possibilities are endless when we make our 3-dimensional friends of flight, with color, a little mess, and pure delight! You'll learn classic paper mache technique to create tropical birds of your own design, then paint and decorate them according to the flights of your own imagination. By the end of the week, you'll have your own bird to fly home with you!</p>
W E E K 6	<p>July 25 -29</p> <p><u>Textile Artistry:</u></p> <p>Teacher : Lisa Phipps</p>	<p>In this class students will learn a variety of textile techniques--cutting, dyeing, singeing and applique--to create a vibrant natural scene from silk fabric and ribbon. We will first dye the material in a variety of colors, then cut, shape, layer and sew the pieces to build a 14" x 14" wall-hanging. At the end of the week, each artist will leave with a beautiful creation to hang at home.</p>
